Purpose

The purpose of this Addendum is to incorporate requirements mandated by 2025 Senate Bill 36 (SB36), codified in Chapter 138, which restricts the use or disclosure of MVD records for purposes of federal immigration enforcement.

Addendum Terms

Use and Disclosure Restrictions

The following provision is hereby added to the contract:

The Recipient agrees that any records, data, or information received from or on behalf of the New Mexico Taxation and Revenue Department (TRD) or the New Mexico Motor Vehicle Division (MVD), whether directly or indirectly, including through a database or automated network, shall not be used or disclosed for the purpose of enforcing the federal Immigration and Nationality Act (INA), as amended, except felony criminal provisions of that act

This restriction applies to all forms of data access, including but not limited to, viewing, sharing, transmitting, storing, or otherwise making records or information available to federal or third-party entities.

The Recipient shall implement internal policies, procedures, and controls to ensure compliance with this provision and shall require the same of any subcontractors, agents, or affiliates who access such records or information under this Agreement.

Any violation of this provision shall be considered a material breach of contract and may result in immediate termination of this Agreement, in addition to any other remedies available under law. If the director of the Motor Vehicle Division of the Procuring Agency determines, in the director's sole judgment, that a nongovernmental entity has used or disclosed records or information for the purpose of enforcing the federal Immigration and Nationality Act other than felony criminal provisions of that act, the director, in the director's sole discretion, may revoke the nongovernmental entity's access to personal information pursuant to Subsection A of NMSA 1978, Section 66-2-7.1.

Effect

Except as specifically set forth in this Amendment, all other terms and conditions of the original contract and previous amendments thereto remain in full force and effect.
